

York Commencement History

In 1959, York School opened its doors in Pacific Grove with 12 boys in the 7th grade. The School moved to its current location in 1964 and the next year held its first commencement ceremony. On June 12, 1965, 11 members of the Class of 1965 received their diplomas and were celebrated as the young school's first graduates.

In 1970, York became co-ed and three girls who enrolled as seniors that year graduated in 1971. York's first female valedictorian was Marianne Gawain in 1976. Including the Class of 2025, York has had a total of 77 valedictorians.

The first commencement, and almost all subsequent ones, was celebrated in the Coburn Commons. Only twice has the ceremony been held indoors due to inclement weather—in 1993 and 2012. In 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, commencement was held in the upper parking lot, and it was held on the Upper Field in



2021. The school started a new tradition in 2022, holding commencement in the Gawain Family Theater for the first time.

For the past 20 years, the ceremony has increasingly focused on our students and teachers. Featured speakers are members of the graduating class and a faculty member selected to speak by the graduates. The role of the faculty speaker is to deliver a "charge" to the graduates as they commence the next chapter in their lives.

Finally, the graduates are welcomed to the York Alumni Community by a representative from the ranks.

To date, 2,111 students have graduated from York School. Today, we add 32 more graduates to our alumni community, the Class of 2025. We commend this year's graduating class and look forward to seeing where their paths lead them. Congratulations!
